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### Distribution Loss Adjustment Factors

Voltage Level	Time Period		
	Composite	Day	Night
38kV Sales	1.017	1.018	1.014
MV Sales	1.038	1.040	1.032
LV Sales	1.084	1.089	1.072
Aggregate	1.072	1.076	1.061

The major time periods relate to the day and night rate units used in the two part tariffs. These time periods are applied as follows:

- For customers connected at Low Voltage (LV) with non quarter-hourly meters:

The day period covers the time from 8.00am to 11.00pm each day during the winter months and from 9.00am to 12.00pm during the rest of the year.

- For LV customers with quarter-hourly meters, Medium Voltage (MV) and 38kV customers:

The day period covers the time from 8.00 a.m. to 11.00 p.m. for every day of the year.  
The night period covers the remaining hours from 11.00pm to 8.00am.

Only the day and night loss adjustment factors are used for settlement purposes.
